Park cars in RTA lay-by at 693/622(M) - walk west uphill to approx. 690/623(M), then head NE down ridge to Musgrave Ck - spend until lunch-time exploring upstream - after lunch, follow creek downstream to track on right just before Musgrave hits Currowan Ck (approx. 718/631(M)) - follow this track west running parallel to King's Hwy back to cars.

Wonderful walk - not particularly hard.

Bushbush down fairly sparsely treed ridge to
creek. Tree trunks just above creek thickly covered
with moss + tiny pale yellow orchids in flower -
hundreds of them.

Creek very shallow + easy to walk in with a stick.

Track out easy to find. Brings you out onto
Leechey Flat. Track up hill to gate well
graded + not too steep.

After gate follow ridge above King's Hwy
back to cars - not really a track - pretty overgrown
+ a little steep in places.
