Exploring the Deva River + Pinkwood Creek

From cars parked at 600110 (Nerrigundah), follow the Coondella Trail northwest to first track off to left, which is taken to Deva River at 588108 (N). Follow river upstream (to right) until junction with Pinkwood Creek at 590113 (N). Follow Pinkwood Creek upstream to Coondella Trail at 595118 (N). Follow Coondella Trail southeast, back to cars.
