FROM THE CARS, GO UP MOUNTAIN RD TO THE SW AND ENTER FOREST AT 584591 IN A SOUTHERLY DIRECTION. THE FIRST CREEK REACHED IS AN UPPER TRIBUTORY OF UNION CAMP CREEK. WE FOLLOW THIS DOWNSTREAM TILL IT MEETS A SE TRIBUTORY. WE FOLLOW THIS UPSTREAM & TILL A POINT WHERE IT'S POSSIBLE TO CUT ACROSS (NE) TO THE ORIGINAL CREEK. WE THEN FOLLOW THIS DOWNSTREAM. IT IS POSSIBLE AT SOME POINT, TO EXIT THE AREA TO THE SOUTH TO MEET UP WITH THE TRACK ON THE TOP OF THE ESCARPMENT, IF THE BIG TREE IS FOUND!
