FROM THE NP CARPARK, TAKE THE WCG WCC TRACK TO THE CORANG PRATEAC, TAKING THE RT HAND TRACK AT FORANG HEAK. DOWN THE CONGLOMERATE ROCK FACE TO SNOWIE BROOK, THEN ON TO CORANG BROOK TO REACH A CAVE FOR AN OVERNIGHT STAY. 2ND DAY GO BACK TO SNOWIE BROOK (370930) AND FOLLOW THIS BROOK TOWARDS THE NW TO REACH (WITH SOME DIFFICULTY) MANY ROCK RIDES AT THE JUNCTION OF CORANG RIVER. SOME NAVIGATION IS NEEDED TO REACH CORANG 351945 (CASCADES) WHERE THE GROUP WILL CAMP FOR THE NIGHT. THE WATER RACE WILL BE EXPLORED BEFORE OUR RETURN TO THE CARS VIA THE CASCADE TRACK.
